School Health Advisory System

Green	Categorization as "green" suggests that the county has a relatively low COVID-19 risk and that in-person instruction can be adopted, although a SAU may opt for hybrid instruction if its buildings or readiness make adhering to the Required Health and Safety Measures for All Schools a challenge.
Yellow	Categorization as "yellow" suggests that the county has an elevated risk of COVID-19 spread and that hybrid instruction models should be adopted.
Red	Categorization as "red" suggests that the county has a high risk of COVID-19 spread and that in-person instruction should not be conducted.










Student Survey Data July 2020

Student Responses Continued

"I don't believe we should return to school until there are no more cases in Maine. Tourists raise the risk of coronavirus cases greatly."

"I would really like to return to school in the fall because remote learning wasn't ideal for me"

"I'm not really comfortable with going back because it would put me and my mom at a higher risk. A school is like the breeding ground for germs."

"I think remote learning is more complex and I think returning to school is best."


"I miss friends but it might be too soon"






- My child(ren) would engage in distance learning through school provided resources


Do you feel comfortable returning to school with all of our students present while taking the precautions outlined in the CSD Opening Plan (green level)?


Distance Learning


