## MCI Athletics Visitor Guidelines

All spring athletic contests are played at Manson Park with the exception of outdoor track & field which hosts the Husky Throwdown on the Alumni Athletic Complex (guidance for the Husky Throwdown will be sent separately). Unified Bocce will be played on the MCI campus (guidance will be sent separately).

## Spectator Information

Manson Park is not on the MCI campus and is a public park. Spectators with mobility issues should contact the Director of Athletics & Activities (jallen@mci-school.org or (207) 416-4427) prior to arriving to make arrangements for getting to the fields. Spectators must stay in the designated viewing areas (either roped or marked with dashed white lines).

## Team Information

Teams should provide their own water. Coolers, cups and water bottles will not be provided. Refilling of water can be arranged with the Director of Athletics. Trash cans will be provided in team areas but coaches should make sure that those team areas are orderly prior to leaving the facility. Medical Coverage will be provided by Northern Light Sports Medicine, certified athletic trainer Patrick Hapworth.

## Directions to Manson Park:

*From I-95, Exit 150:* Follow Somerset Ave. to Rte. 100, turning right at the stop light. Follow Rte. 100 taking the first left after crossing the railroad tracks. Go around the divider to enter the park. The baseball field is the first field upon entering the park, visitors will be in the 3rd Base dugout. The softball field is the second field upon entering the park, visitors will be in the 1st Base dugout. Girls Lacrosse plays in the large field after leaving the paved roadway, the tennis courts are at the end of the dirt parking area adjacent to the lacrosse field.

*From Midcoast through Unity:* In Unity, turn right off Rte. 139 onto Prairie Rd. which turns into the Horseback Rd. in Burnham follow all the way to Pittsfield, turning right onto Rte. 100 across from the MCI campus. Take the second right off Rte. 100 across from the Public Library. Go around the divider to enter the park. The baseball field is the first field upon entering the park, visitors will be in the 3rd Base dugout. The softball field is the second field upon entering the park, visitors will be in the 1st Base dugout. Girls Lacrosse plays in the large field after leaving the paved roadway, the tennis courts are at the end of the dirt parking area adjacent to the lacrosse field.
